“Founded in Europe in 2008, MidVision is a privately held company with its headquarters in London and New York City. MidVision is focused on selling tools and consulting services for application release automation.”

MidVision’s ARA product, RapidDeploy, was released in 2010. It provides provisioning, deployment, release automation and a configuration management functionality. MidVision supplies tooling and consulting for the enablement of enterprise continuous delivery workflows, agile development practices, operations practices and cloud infrastructure hosting. RapidDeploy v.4.0 (released January 2016) focused on usage simplification, support for linked deployments, orchestration for specific environments and more plug-ins to tools that support the continuous delivery.”

“MidVision has experienced revenue growth in recent years by delivering RapidDeploy with flexible licensing options and good integration with third-party tools that support RapidDeploy in the continual delivery pipeline (e.g., Docker).”

“RapidDeploy can be downloaded for a 30- or 90-day trial period and used on-premises or hosted off-premises. MidVision continues to expand sales through an increase in indirect channels and expansion of direct sales in the U.S. MidVision’s customer base is spread through a diverse range of industries that is continuously growing, including financial services, pharmaceutical, healthcare, insurance, government and retail.”
